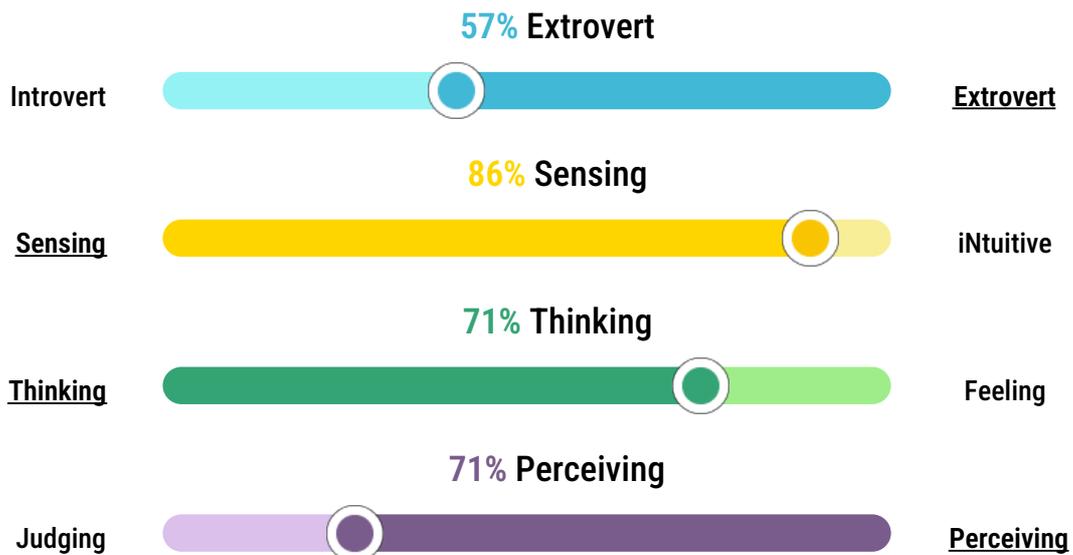

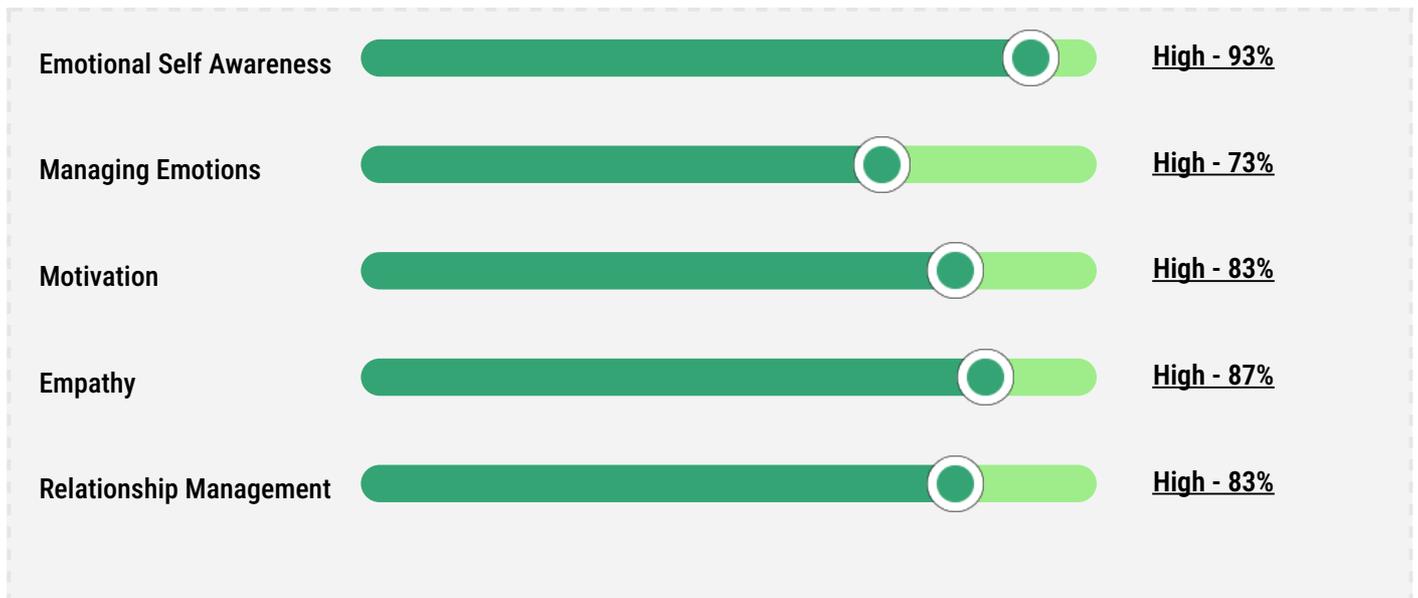
- Kinesthetic (or tactile) learners learn best by touching and doing.

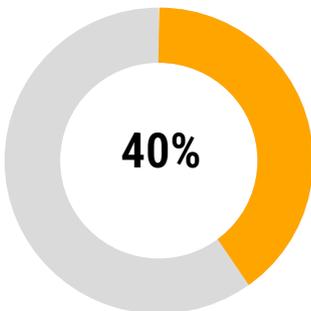

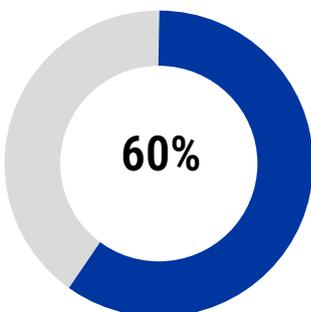

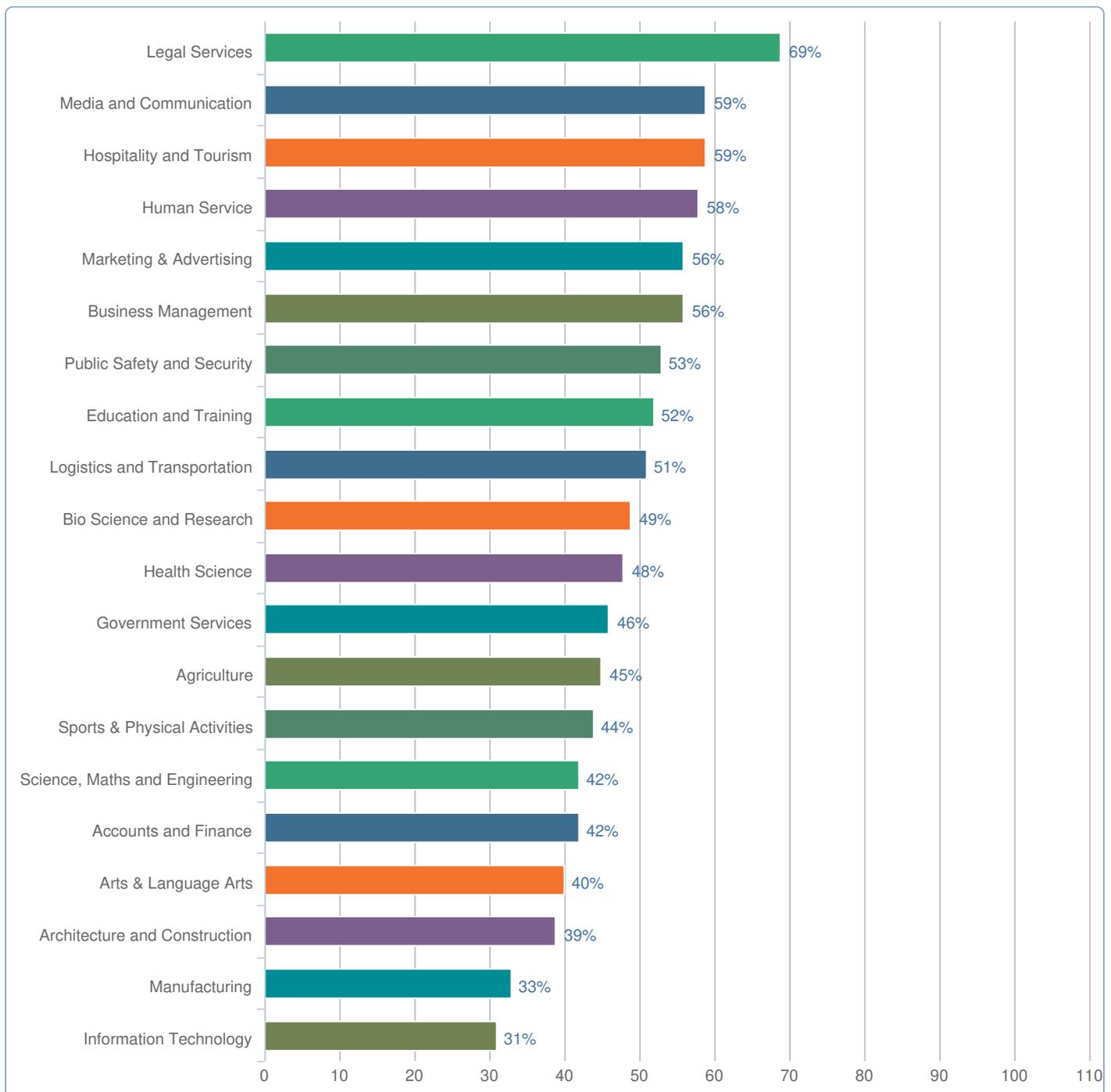
